

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

**CONTRACTORS TAKE NOTICE.** The City of Stamford, in an effort to advise the general public of the opportunity for bidding on the construction of the Stamford Urban Transitway project will hold a public information meeting. The Stamford Urban Transitway project consists of one mile of roadway which will provide a direct connection south of the railroad tracks to the Stamford Transportation Center. The project begins south of the railroad tracks, along Cherry Street, and along Jefferson Street between Elm Street and Canal Street and extends a new roadway through Dock Street to Station Place between Canal Street and Atlantic Street.

**A Public Information Meeting to review the general scope of the project and any special requirements for potential bidders will be held on November 17, 2006 at the Stamford Government Center, 888 Washington Boulevard, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor Café, Stamford, CT 06901 during the hours of 2:30 pm – 4:00 pm.**

The meeting will review the location of the project, the schedule for completion, utility coordination, and any special requirements of potential bidders such as Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation.

It is the policy of the City of Stamford to keep the public informed and involved when projects are undertaken. It is important to make potential bidders aware of opportunity to bid on this project. The goal of the City is to obtain the most competitive and responsive bids possible. This meeting is not considered a pre-bid mandatory meeting. It is for general informational purposes only. **A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held at a future date.**
