## PARK RULES

### City ordinances prohibit you to:

- Wantonly damage or remove lawns, trees, shrubs, or flowers, benches, bleachers, drinking fountains or any other property or equipment.
- Discard paper, trash, rubbish, glass, crockery or metal -except in containers provided by the Parks Department for such purposes- and no household debris at any time.
- Have an unleashed animal except in a vehicle.
- Peddle or sell goods, merchandise or food without a City license and Cashiering & Permitting permit.
- Light fires except in picnic grills or fireplaces placed by the Parks Department.
- Hold mass meetings or public assemblies except with a City permit.
- Serve or consume intoxicating or alcoholic beverages except beer.
- Possess alcohol, including beer, after 9:00 p.m.
- Drive a vehicle at speeds over 15 M.P.H. or to park such vehicle except in areas designated for such purposes.
- Use glass bottles or containers of any kind.
- Park in designated areas between Memorial Day and Labor Day without a City Park Permit.
- Make loud or disturbing noises, including amplified music.
- Wash or repair vehicles in the parks.
- Play ball or organized games without a permit, except in areas plainly designated for such activities.
- Swim in restricted areas.
- Post signs on trees or other park property.
- Disobey posted signs or warnings.
- Drive or chip golf balls in a park.
- Hunt, trap or pursue wild life at any time on public park land.
- Landing, beaching, mooring or securing a boat at any designated swimming beach, or discharging persons onto said beach.
- **Picnics of 30 people or more MUST have a permit.**

### City Park Permits are required at Cove Island Park, Cummings Park, West Beach, Southfield and Dorothy Heroy Park from Memorial Day through Labor Day.

#### To obtain a City Park Permit please show:

1. Current vehicle registration
2. Driver's license (62 and over)
3. Utility bill (electric/oil/gas) plus license if vehicle is NOT registered in Stamford.
