A Regular Meeting of the Stamford Police Commission was held on Monday, September 14, 2009 at 5:30 pm at Stamford Police Headquarters.

Also present was Chief Brent B. Larrabee, Ex-Officio, Assistant Chief Bob Nivakoff, Assistant Chief Sue Bretthauer and Sergeant Joe Kennedy.

The meeting was called to order at 5:50 pm.

**Review of Minutes**

A MOTION was made by Commissioner Berkoff and seconded by Commissioner Maloney and approved unanimously, to approve the minutes of the August Regular Meeting.

**Comments from Public**

Carol Henderson introduced herself and commented that she would like to be involved in the NAACP training.

George Bachman has a complaint that he wanted to bring to the attention of the Commission. Chief Larrabee said that the complaint is being handled in Internal Affairs and it was improper for the Commission to hear his complaint until after the investigation has been completed.

**A&O Report**

Chief Larrabee reported:

- Elliott Spector has been retained to review the IA Process on complaints and make suggestions on the complaint policy.
- Grant money has been approved for a Youth Court, Cadet Program and Outreach workers.
- Violent crime for 2008 is up 16%.

Assistant Chief Nivakoff reported:

- Officer W. Mercado rescued a man from a burning car.
- Bob Somody Police Officer of the Year.
- Burglaries way up.
- Robberies are up.

- Working with FBI, ICE and Homeland Security on high level programs.
- Arrested a smash and grab man.
- Have 177 candidates on a certified list.
- Officer Rainone back working in jail.
- Made arrest of 2 suspects in 11 bank robberies in the area.

There being no further business to discuss, A MOTION was made by Commissioner Maloney and seconded by Commissioner Berkoff and approved unanimously, to adjourn the meeting at 7:25 pm.
