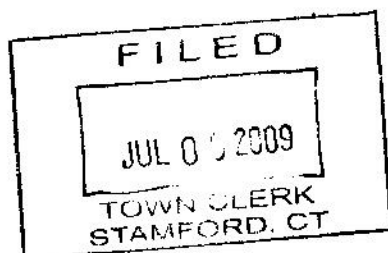


STAMFORD POLICE DEPARTMENT

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A Regular Meeting of the Stamford Police Commission was held on Monday, June 1, 2009 at 5:30 pm at Stamford Police Headquarters.

Present at the meeting were Commissioner Mark Denham, Chairman, Commissioner Michael Berkoff, Commissioner Adele Gordon and Commissioner Stephen Maloney. Also present was Chief Brent B. Larrabee, Ex-Officio, Assistant Chief Bob Nivakoff, and Assistant Chief Susan Bretthauer. Absent was Commissioner Reverend Dr. Robert Perry.

The meeting was called to order at 5:43 pm.

Review of Minutes

A&O Report

Chief Larrabee reported:

- **Impending lay off of officers. There has been no agreement between the Association and the City.**
- **Statistics are out for 2008. Stamford is still the 3rd safest City in the Northeast.**

Commissioner Maloney asked about the Police Academy.

Chief Larrabee reported that there are no prospects for a new Academy.

Assistant Chief Bretthauer reported that Domus would be using Rogers school.

Commissioner Maloney asked about the selection process from the recent test for Police Officer.

Chief Larrabee said that the oral boards are being held.

Assistant Chief Nivakoff reported:

- 7 stabbings, 3 robberies and a shooting recently.
- Burglaries and street robberies are up.
- 1st County Bank on Hope Street held up.

Chief Larrabee reported:

- Violence crime up 13% - mostly crimes of opportunity.

Assistant Chief Nivakoff reported:

- Commercial and residential burglaries up.

Chief Larrabee reminded the commissioner of the Police Officer of the Year Dinner.
